



Giving Options

Annual Ministry Fund: Bethel's primary source of income is gifts from the congregation to the AMF or general fund. These gifts go directly to meet the needs of the MFP.

Building Fund: used to make principle and interest payments on the loan on our building.

Benevolence Fund: used to help individuals and families in our congregation with special financial needs.

Short Term Projects: These funds are preapproved by our Elders, and receive gifts for a very specific purpose and a specific period of time. Examples would be a short term missions (GO) trip, Advent in Action, and youth projects or trips. These needs are communicated via our website, the Bethel Weekly, letters and announcements.



Online Giving

Living "debt free" is a worthy goal for all Christians. We offer online giving only as a convenience and not as a way to circumvent sound biblical money management principles or incur debt. When you are ready to give online, you can have confidence knowing that our payment system is secure. Our system allows you to give using a debit/credit card or an automatic withdrawal from your bank account. You will also be able to designate where your giving goes (general-AMF, building, benevolence, etc.) as well as determine the frequency. If you have more questions check out our FAQ's online.

Ministry Funding Plan

Bethel's Ministry Funding Plan (MFP), or budget, is prepared each fall from the requests of ministries and administration for the following year. Based on giving from the current year, leadership compiles the requests and makes adjustments as necessary. The proposed MFP is presented to the congregation for approval at the Annual Meeting in January. The new MFP becomes the guideline for Bethel's spending throughout the year.
