

Taking it Home

- If you and I want to live the legacy we want to leave, it begins with love. Remind yourself of the truth of 1 Corinthians 13. We could do everything right and make lots of outward motions but if it is not motivated by love, it will not last. Where do you have an opportunity to express legacy through love in your family this week?
- If you were to die today, what elements of your life will you leave behind that make you proud to be a follower of Jesus? What qualities have you given to those near to you that they might know, love, and serve Jesus?
- There is no lasting legacy apart from relationships. Living the legacy you want to leave will require intentionality. Don't become the person who at the end of their life can only celebrate their status or their stuff. People matter. Helping people know Jesus matters most. Who is someone this week that you can point to Jesus?
- Start small and pray big. Ask God to show you who He wants you to live out your legacy with so that you will leave behind a legacy of taking others to Jesus. Because of Christ's love, how can you share your influence with others in meaningful ways? Who can you invite into your sphere of influence to be invested in or to invest in you or those near you? Who is someone that you can encourage?
