Proverbs 22 – what does the wisdom of Solomon teach us about living our lives today? Join us as we journey through Proverbs 22 this summer and grow wise in how you live your life before the face of God.

1. Debt is not ruled out in Scripture, but neither is it advocated. There is always a warning - *danger* - when debt is discussed. Why is debt dangerous?
2. How does debt presume upon tomorrow? How does debt cloud the line that separates wants, desires, and needs? (Read James 4:13-17)
3. Here are some spiritual questions you can ask yourself when you are considering purchases, in order to check your motives:
 - Is my not having enough resources for what I want God's way of telling me that it is not his will for me to buy this?
 - With debt am I saying that I don't believe God knows best what my needs are, and that God has failed to meet my needs?
 - Is God wanting me to pray for his provision rather than make my own provision for the funds that I think I need?
 - Is borrowing a statement of my doubts about his power, his goodness, or his love for me, as well as his promises to provide?
