1. Why is the fear of God the beginning of wisdom (Job 28:28; Ps. 111:10; Pr. 9:10)
2. *Christian wisdom is a conforming of the mind to the gospel* (Graeme Goldsworthy). How does that definition change your view of wisdom?
3. Ecclesiastes 12:13 - **The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.**
If the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom, then true wisdom begins with salvation, and the wise person is first of all the saved person. Living in line with the truth of the gospel (Gal. 2:14) is by living in wisdom. Using wisdom is an application of the gospel in our lives. Talk about what this means in your life.
