2. The God of Abraham (Genesis 12–50)

3. The God of Moses (Exodus–Deuteronomy)  
*Exodus 12:13, “The Lord said to Moses, ‘When I see the blood of the lamb, I will pass over you.’”*

# At Home Study Guide

For the week of January 2, 2022

*It can often be helpful to zoom out on an image to get the big picture. We want to help you to know God's Word better this month by giving you The Big Picture, a view of the whole story of God's Word, from Eden to Eternity. Over the five Sundays in January we will cover God's promises made in the Old Testament, and God's promises kept in the New Testament, in order to help you grow in your knowledge of God and his Word.*
