 - Even though you don't deserve it, I welcome you.
3. To Mary: *"Woman, this is your son."*
To John: *"This is your mother."* John 19:26-27
 - Even in my suffering, I think of others. I think of you too.
4. *"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? ..."* Matthew 27:46
 - This is Psalm 22. It ends, *"The sacrifice to save all future generations—I have done it!"*
5. *"I thirst."* John 19:28
 - I am fully human, taking your place.
6. *"It is finished;"* John 19:30
 - I am fully God, paying your debt in full.
7. *"Father, into your hands I commit my spirit."* Luke 23:46
 - I died for you so you can live for me.
