Luke 16:19-31

*Bethel's Mission is described simply as **Love God – Love Others – Serve the World**. These phrases are the basis for our Vision and Values. As you consider the passage this week, look at it through the lens of our Mission/Vision/Values and allow it to clarify what you believe and guide how you live.*

In this parable there is an ongoing challenge to the religious leaders of the day, those Jesus depicted as the older brother in chapter 15. How is the rich man in this parable like the religious leaders of that day?

LOVE OTHERS: Who are the poor and needy that Jesus places in your path regularly?

SERVE THE WORLD: God has given us his Word, but he has also gone the extra step and sent his Son to rise from the dead to prove the truth of his Word. In what ways can you take God's Word to a needy world that needs to know the truth?
