 - *Ephesians 1:13-14* - ¹³ And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

 - *Ephesians 5:15-18a* - ¹⁵ Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. ¹⁸ Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. At Home Study Guide

For the week of April 8, 2018

Ephesians 1:13-14

*Bethel's Mission is described simply as **Love God – Love Others – Serve the World**. These phrases are the basis for our Vision and Values. As you consider the passage this week, look at it through the lens of our Mission/Vision/Values and allow it to clarify what you believe and guide how you live.*

The Holy Spirit is often called the forgotten member of the Trinity, because we forget about his presence and work in our lives as believers. How have you forgotten that you have the Holy Spirit working in you?

Paul describes him as the promised Holy Spirit. Read *Ezekiel 36:26-27*. What does God promise that the Holy Spirit will do? Does God keep his promises?

The Holy Spirit is also a seal. When you see a seal on a document, what does that mean? How is the Holy Spirit a seal for us, in a similar way?

Paul also says that the Holy Spirit is a guarantee, or a down payment. He is something like an engagement ring given to us. What does that mean to you? How does it encourage you that the Holy Spirit is a promise, a seal, and a guarantee?
