The Bible gives simple instructions on how to live. Ephesians 5:1-2 keeps it simple, instructing us to be imitators of God and walk in love. How do we practically live that out? Follow along as we consider a new truth each week to help us live as God's dearly loved children.

1. Read Acts 16 and notice all that God did to lead Paul to Philippi and start a church in that city. Think back to how God made you a partaker of his grace, and who God used in your life in that process.
2. Who are your partners in the gospel? Who do you serve with, reach others with, pray with for the gospel to be advanced? In what way could you follow God in faith to love others and serve the world?
3. God preserves us and helps us to persevere. Read John 10:27-28 and Romans 8:38-39. How are those verses an encouragement to you?
4. God has a purpose for preserving us, according to Philippians 1:6. What good works has he begun in you and through you? How have you seen God's purposes for you?
