# At Home Study Guide

For the week of June 3, 2018

*1 Samuel 16*

*During June and July we will consider the life of David. He was a man who lived his life on mission: loving God, loving others, and serving the world. Consider how he points us to Jesus, through whom we can live out the same mission.*

Saul was the first king of Israel, and David followed him. Look back at 1 Samuel 13 and 15 to see why Saul was rejected by God as king.

What does God look for in a person (*1 Samuel 16:7*)? How does that truth help you determine where you should focus your energy in your life? What are ways you can strengthen your heart focus?

References to the Spirit of the Lord in the Old Testament are different than what we understand as the Holy Spirit that Jesus sent in the New Testament. The Spirit of the Lord came upon specific people for specific reasons – for David, it was to enable him to lead as king.

Jesus also was rejected because people looked at what he did instead who he was (see *Isaiah 53:1-3*). Consider *1 Corinthians 1:18-31*. How has God humbled you and used you, so that you can boast in the Lord and what he has done through you?
