For the week of June 17, 2018

Ephesians 3:14-19

Today, Father's Day, we are going to consider the heart of the Father – God – toward His children. As you study this passage, think about what God wants you to know, feel, and do as His child. If you are not a child of God, not adopted into His family yet, confess, repent of your sins, and trust God by faith today!

This section (*Ephesians 3:14-19*) is a prayer offered up to God by Paul. Notice and write down what items Paul prays for, and what he doesn't pray about that might typically be our prayer concerns.

God wants to dwell in your inner being like a friend who might live permanently in your home with you. Think about your spiritual heart, your inner being, as a home for Jesus. What areas would Jesus want to help you repair or clean up? What would He want to help you throw away?

Why is it hard to trust God's love for you? What are some things God has done for you in your past that show the greatness of His love?

There are certain attributes of God that we are not able to share – God is eternal, He doesn't change, He is all powerful. But there are other attributes that we can share with God, although in a lesser way. The fruit of the Spirit are a good example. How can you improve the quality of your relationship with God so that you become more like Him?
