# At Home Study Guide

For the week of August 23, 2020

*God is light. God is love. Both are simple statements with profound implications. John digs into these truths in the letter called 1 John. Pray and think over this 9 week series about how God's light and God's love affect how to relate to God, others, and the world.*

1. 1 John 4:7-21 highlights the major themes of the letter: love is from God, so believers must love one another. According to verse 10, how did God first love us?
2. Why does our sin bring upon us God's divine wrath? Propitiation means to turn aside the wrath of God by means of a sacrifice. How does Jesus do that for those who trust him? (see verses 10, 17-18)
3. How has God's love changed you to love others more fully?
