At Home Study Guide

For the week of September 2, 2018

Read 2 Cor. 4:1-6. What is the treasure that Paul speaks of in 2 Cor. 4:7?

What is Paul referring to when he speaks of “jars of clay?” How does the contrast between the treasure and the jars help you understand Paul’s point?

Read 2 Cor. 11:23-33 to see the type of situations that Paul refers to in 2 Cor. 4:8-9. How did Paul sustain hope and encouragement through all these various times of suffering?

Paul shifts to the analogy of the death of Jesus in verses 10-12. Jesus had to suffer and die in order to be resurrected and ascend to the father. Consider how, like Paul, your suffering is a witness to the power of God. In what ways do you need to grow in your trust in God’s power?
