Heaven – do we really have an accurate understanding of our eternal home? We hope this series will help you understand the glorious truths of the Bible more fully so that you will grow in joy as you think about heaven. Use this guide in your small group or as a regular reflection on the truths of the past Sunday's sermon.

Day 1: We are all embodied individuals. We are created with a body. What have you thought about your bodily existence after death (read 1 Cor. 15:35-44)?
