# At Home Study Guide

*As we study the book of Ephesians, remember that Paul was writing to them to challenge them to think of themselves as people in Christ – people who had been given a new identity. In the same way, as you study this book, consider what Paul is teaching you about your identity in Christ.*

Do you remember how you walked or lived as an unbeliever? How is the description in verses 17-19 accurate and helpful to you?

How have you learned Christ? Why is it significant that Paul describes our life as learning to follow a person and learning to be like God?

Paul describes in verses 25-32 how our relationships are to be new and different. Which of his commands are particularly challenging or difficult for you? How can you by faith become who you really are in these areas?
