At Home Study Guide

For the week of October 23, 2022

Heaven – do we really have an accurate understanding of our eternal home? We hope this series will help you understand the glorious truths of the Bible more fully, so that you will grow in joy as you think about heaven. Use this guide in your small group or as a regular reflection on the truths of the past Sunday's sermon.

Day 1: Think about Gen. 3:8 and God's relationship with Adam and Eve before sin. What does the Garden of Eden tell us about God's desire to be with his people?

Day 2: Read Exodus 25:8-9. What do these verses tell us about God's desire to be with his people?

Day 3: Read Psalm 90:1. A major theme of the Bible is God's desire to be with his people. In what ways is that encouraging to you?

Day 4: Read Revelation 21:3. The Bible ends where it began, with God's desire to be with us. How does that give you hope as you look forward to heaven?
