Acts 1–2

As we wrap up one year and move on into a new calendar, it is often time of reflection and assessment. The disciples had a similar time of transition in Acts 1, after Jesus ascended into heaven, and before the day of Pentecost and the pouring out of the Spirit. Read through Acts 1 and use it to guide you as you look back over the past year and forward to the New Year.

1. Before Jesus rose into heaven, he made a promise to those who were present. What was that promise (Acts 1:6-8)? As a Christian and follower of Jesus, how is that encouraging to you as you move into the New Year?

2. In Acts 1:12-14 what did the followers of Jesus do next? Why do you think those things were important things to do? How could you follow that pattern?

3. Acts 1:15-26 tell us about how the disciples moved forward in ministry. Things didn't end after Jesus left, but it might feel that way for you if you experienced some kind of significant life change last year. What do you learn here that can help you move forward in faith?
