Quick Review

This summer we are considering stories from the Old Testament and their abiding relevance today. As you study the passage, look beyond your notes to glean more truth from this passage by using these questions, so that you can find a greater harvest of truth!

Context: *Page thru the first few chapters of Joshua. What events led up to chapter 6? How does chapter 5, especially verses 13-15, help you understand chapter 6?*

Observation: *This method of attack seems very strange. What do you not find in this passage concerning the taking of the city? What else is significant in this passage?*

Meaning: *The themes of faith, judgment, and mercy run through Joshua 6. Why did God judge their sin? Why was mercy shown to Rahab and her family? Who exercised faith?*

Application: *Look at the references to Rahab in the New Testament (Matt. 1:5; Heb. 11:31; James 2:25). How does this story and her life teach us how to follow God?*
