Quick Review

This summer we are considering stories from the Old Testament and their abiding relevance today. As you study the passage, look beyond your notes to glean more truth from this passage by using these questions, so that you can find a greater harvest of truth!

Context: Read Judges 2:10-23. How does that help you understand the context of the book of Judges better? Look at chapter 6 to understand the call of Gideon.

Observation: What significant details do you notice in chapter 7? How did people respond when God punished them for their sin?

Meaning: How does punishment for sin and the provision of the judges point us forward to Christ? How did Jesus succeed where judges failed?

Application: Do you see your sin for what it is? How do sin and lack of trust function together in your life? What happens in your life after you receive the Lord's discipline?
